## Code of Conduct

Please read this code of conduct and make sure that your child understands this

### A) Players

1. Play fairly and honestly.
2. No verbal abuse, bad language or foul play.
3. Applaud good play, by both your team-mates and the opposition.
4. Do not expect to play in all matches. If you are a substitute, support your team.
5. Appearance – for training and matches arrive with the correct playing kit.
6. Punctuality – arrive on time. If there is a problem attending, please notify your coach, especially for matches.
7. Respect all players, coaches, managers and spectators

### B) Parents/Guardians

1. Help, encourage and support all children, praise fair play and good behaviour.
2. Do not shout instructions to players, the coach will provide this information (too much confuses players and spoils enjoyment).
3. Accept all decisions made by officials.
4. The Club emphasis from U11 down is on player development and enjoyment, therefore Team Training is considered more important than matches. Performance goals far outweigh outcome goals, ie/ 'How did you play' as opposed to 'Did you win ?'
5. Display patience – children are not mini adults; do not expect too much either physically or mentally.
6. Everyone at the club is approachable – any problems or constructive feedback is greatly appreciated, in the correct manner, at the right time.
7. Read the FA Mini Soccer handbook, particularly their codes of conduct.
8. Respect all players, coaches, managers and spectators
